

# Submission Guidelines

All proposals must be submitted by July 15, 2022.

## Proposal Guidelines

- Paper proposals, written in English in a Word or PDF file format, should clearly identify the research questions and methodology. If available, the main results, implications, and contributions should also be briefly discussed.
- Paper proposals are limited to 2 pages of text (up to 1,000 words) and 1 additional page of references.
- Submissions must be accompanied by a 250-word abstract for inclusion in the Conference Program. This will be entered directly into the submission form, so it does not need to be included in the proposal document.
- Use 1.5 spacing with 1-inch margins and a font size no smaller than 11 pt.
- The title of your paper must be included in the header of the proposal and should exactly match the title provided in the online submission form.
- Please do not include any author identifying information in the proposal.
- Presenting authors must be available to present their papers any time during the conference.
- References should be formatted in APA style.

## Please note:

To ensure anonymity, author names should NOT be identified in the body of the proposal.
